Requests the Director General to: support local authorities in the initiation and development of a food policy integrated with other policies; defend, support and encourage the development and strengthening of pacts between authorities and actors in the local agri-food system; and facilitate at the level of IUCN the sharing and exchange of tools, methods and good practices that reinforce the participatory approach in the territories involved in this type of strategy.</p>

Law 2/2014 of the Action and Foreign Service of the State (includes "Foreign Action in agrarian, food, fishing and environmental matters"), Code of Agrarian Law (X) Rural Development, which includes Royal Decree 1010/2015 (establishing the regulatory bases for the granting of aid for tangible or intangible investments in the processing, marketing and development of agricultural products within the framework of the National Rural Development Programme 2014-2020 for the promotion of the integration of supra-autonomous agri-food associations), Royal Decree 126/2016 (establishing the regulatory bases for the granting of aid for demonstration activities and information actions, within the framework of the National Rural Development Programme 2014-2020, for the promotion of the integration of supra-autonomous agri-food associations), Royal Decree 312/2016 (establishing the regulatory bases for the granting of aid to support vocational training and skills acquisition activities within the framework of the National Rural Development Programme 2014-2020, for the promotion of the integration of supra-autonomous agri-food associations)], Law 3/2019 of 31 January, Agraria de les Illes Balears, Royal Decree 430/2020 (developing the basic organic structure of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, and amending Royal Decree 139/2020 of 28 January, establishing the basic organic structure of the ministerial departments, Order HAC/20/2020, of 20 January, which lays down the rules for drawing up the General State Budget for 2020 (includes "Agro-food industrial competitiveness and food quality"), Royal Decree-Law 5/2020 (adopting certain urgent measures in the field of agriculture and food)).

Royal Decree 1086/2020, of December 9, which regulates and relaxes certain conditions of application of the provisions of the European Union on hygiene in the production and marketing of food products and regulates activities excluded from its scope of application. It generates opportunities for more than 250,000 small farmers and ranchers.

DECREE 17/2021, of March 24, which regulates the direct supply by owners of agricultural exploitations of small quantities of primary products. (2021040017)
